## COVID-19 (coronavirus) absence: A quick guide for parents / carers

These<br>symptoms can last for<br>several weeks once the<br>infection is gone. |
| somebody<br>in my<br>household<br>has COVID-<br>19 (coronavirus)<br>symptoms*          | <ul> <li>Child shouldn't attend school</li> <li>Household member with<br/>symptoms should get a test</li> <li>Whole household self-isolates<br/>while waiting for test result</li> <li>Inform school immediately<br/>about test results</li> </ul>   | when household<br>member test is<br>negative, and child<br>does not have<br>COVID-19 symptoms*  |
| somebody<br>in my<br>household<br>has tested<br>positive for COVID-19<br>(coronavirus) | <ul> <li>Child shouldn't attend school</li> <li>Whole household self-isolates<br/>for 14 days from day when<br/>symptoms* started (or from<br/>day of test if no symptoms) -<br/>even if someone tests<br/>negative during those 14 days</li> </ul>  | when child has<br>completed 14 days of<br>self-isolation, even if<br>they test negative<br>during the 14 days   |

| we / my<br>child has<br>travelled and<br>has to self-<br>isolate as part of a<br>period of quarantine  | <ul> <li>Do not take unauthorised<br/>leave in term time</li> <li>Consider quarantine<br/>requirements and FCO advice<br/>when booking travel</li> <li>Provide information to school<br/>as per attendance policy</li> <li>Returning from a destination<br/>where quarantine is needed:</li> <li>Child shouldn't attend school</li> <li>Whole household self-isolates<br/>for 14 days – even if they test<br/>negative during those 14 days</li> </ul> | when the<br>quarantine period of<br>14 days has been<br>completed for the<br>child, even if they test<br>negative during those<br>14 days |  |
| we have<br>received<br>advice from a<br>medical /<br>official source that<br>my child must<br>resume shielding   | <ul> <li>Child shouldn't attend school</li> <li>Contact school as advised by attendance officer / pastoral team</li> <li>Child should shield until you are informed that restrictions are lifted and shielding is paused again</li> </ul>  | when school / other<br>agencies inform you<br>that restrictions have<br>been lifted and your<br>child can return to<br>school again       |  |
| l am not<br>sure who<br>should get a<br>test for<br>COVID -19<br>(coronavirus)   | <ul> <li>Only people with symptoms* need to get a test</li> <li>People without symptoms are not advised to get a test, even if they are a 'close contact' of someone who tests positive</li> </ul>   | when conditions<br>above, as matching<br>your situation, are<br>met   |  |
